V. New Business

a) Proposal: All pigs with known pure of color lineage that produce an off-color piglet will maintain their color and line name.

Off-color piglets will be registered as Off-Color Blonde/Red/Swallow Belly. They will maintain the line name. Their registration identifier will be the parents color with an * (B*, R*, or SB*). If the off-color animal is bred to a pure of color animal that matches the lineage color the piglets that meet color standards will be registered as pure of color and maintain line name. The piglets that are born off-color will be labeled as off-color and follow the previously mentioned color scheme.

MBOAR will take the stance that off-color animals of pure of color lineage are discouraged from being used as pure of color breeding stock. The best use of these animals would be for meat or for color combination genetic diversification across color lines.

Discussion-

Barbara discusses how pure of color animals imported from Austria and Hungry with certificates proving pure of color. Occasionally animals would have SB colored piglets. Some of these animals were sold as breeding stock. They are called "Off-Color" by Peter Toth and not allowed to be bred. One of these boars was bred several times and many of his offspring (several generations) were sold throughout the US and Canada as Pure blonde.

This also happened with the Ovar Reds but there are no known pigs in lineages of that off color.

This will become an issue as the genetics narrow more of these may appear with pure of color breeders.

Peter says the board had a significant amount of offline text conversation regarding this. Much of the conversation was lively and proves that we have a very diverse board.

Discusses that the proposal would go include fixing the ones in the past as well as those in the future.

Peter reads above proposal.

Peter discusses how maybe these animals should not be allowed to be registered as a breeder.

Barbara discusses how there are really 3 different breeds that are all Mangalitsa.

Tony Asks if this will effect animal resale value. Discussion says most likely not.

Ryan Asks if really dark SB should be considered off-color.

Barbara Shares a screen to show lineage in ZooEasy of a pig that has an Off-Color in the lineage.

Group Discussion Lots of discussion and explanation regarding Off-Color, Pure of Color, and Color Combination Mangalitsa.

Group Vote all in attendance approved.
